It is grown all over the world. We distinguish three subspecies: garden plum, greengage and mirabelle.

Varieties include: "Blood", "Greengage", "Mariposa", "Narraben", "Santa Rosa", "Wilson", "Agostana", "Blufre", "Sangue di Drago", "Sorriso di Primavera", the large and green "Reneklode Mirabelle" from Nancy.
