Lingonberry varieties

The Lingonberry originates from Eurasia and is very common in the forests of the Scandinavian countries. In Sweden it is called the „Country Red Gold“. In the Balkans it is common in forests, moorlands and heathlands. The Lingonberry is one of the few fruits which have so far been exclusively harvested from plants in their original areas. Harvesting in the forest is difficult and expensive and is a major problem. The main varieties are: „Wildpreiselbeere“, „Koralle“, „Erntedank“, „Entrekrone“, „Erntesegen“, „Ammerland“.
