Redcurrant varieties

Redcurrant originates from North East Europe and North West Asia.

We prefer and mainly process fruits from Poland and the Czech Republic.

The varieties grown in the Czech Republic are: "Jonkherr van Tets", "Rondom", "Rote Holländische" and "Heinemans" while the varieties "Rote Holländische" (for about 55%) and "Rondom" (for about 45%) are to be found in Poland.

Other varieties: "Gyetvan" from Slovakia, "Jonkheer van Tets" and "Rondom" from Hungary.

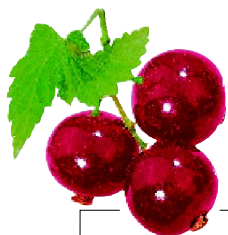
